ABI's Championship Titles

Puppy Championship:

10 points earned by defeating 10 other puppies within 3 - 6 months of age.

Junior Championship:

10 points earned by defeating junior puppies 6 - 12 months of age. Points are carried over towards your Canadian Championship. Once dog turns 12 months of age you must earn 5 more points with one 3 point major to finish out the Canadian Championship.

Canadian Championship:

15 points with two 3 point majors under 2 different judges. Points are earned in Breed, Group & Best In Show.

Altered Championship:

15 points, if no other altered dogs are entered up to judge's discretion if point is awarded to the altered dog.

Master Championship:

Earned by defeating 15 ABIDS Champions.

Grand Master Championship:

Earned by defeating 15 ABIDS Master Champions.

Supreme Master Championship:

Earned by defeating 15 ABIDS Grand Master Champions.
